2A RIGHTS ALERT!

Many of you have already heard about the reclassification of Rare Breed's Force Reset Triggers (FRT's) and the "Ghost Gun" ban. For those of you who haven't, here is the news:

Rare Breed FRT

Rare Breed developed a drop-in AR trigger system a few years back that forced the shooter's trigger finger forward during cycling. This trigger was designed and developed under close oversight by the ATF to ensure that it did not cross any legal lines. At the time of development, and the years that followed, these triggers were marketed and sold in compliance with all ATF rules, guidelines, and laws. Recently, the ATF has made the determination that these triggers are now determined to be "Machine Guns". Any shops that have them on the shelf, or sold these triggers, are having all FRT products and sales records confiscated by ATF officials.

80% Lower Receivers ("Ghost Guns")

First of all, we HATE the term "Ghost Guns". Terms like these are drafted and used by politicians to scare the uneducated public about something that is otherwise very commonplace. An 80% lower is a piece of molded plastic or aluminum that, when cut, drilled, filed or milled out with the help of a jig can be converted into a homemade firearm. The most common company producing these items is Polymer80, but there are many others. The ATF has recently changed their definition of Frame/Receiver to include any item that can be readily converted into a firearm, which means that any of the 80% Lower Receivers would now require a serial number.

The Takeaway

Neither of these may apply to you, but the underlying theme here is unnerving. The ATF does not answer to any legislative process. No laws to draft and pass. The ATF has the authority to change the definitions in their existing laws as they see fit, in order to ban items that have been legal for years. In the process of changing definitions, they are making current law-abiding citizens either forfeit their property, destroy these items, or charge them with felony firearms related crimes. This is what is happening with the FRT's, and what the ATF is hoping to accomplish with the pistol brace/AR pistol definition change.

When will it stop? Short answer is, it wont. Not unless the gun community stands together and collectively does not comply.
